## Notice to our Valued Clients

### Hawaii State Agriculture Fee

Dear Customer,

Please be advised that as of 16<sup>th</sup> October 2008 Hapag Lloyd will be required to collect an Agricultural fee for payment to the Hawaii Department of Agriculture, Plant Quarantine Branch at the port of discharge.

The unchecked spread of invasive species is the single greatest threat to Hawaii's economy, natural environment, and the health and lifestyle of Hawaii's people. The purpose of this fee is to provide funding for the department of agriculture to conduct inspections of imported freight to prevent the introduction of invasive species, and the facilities necessary to conduct such inspections.

The fee will be assessed on the net weight of the imported freight computed on the basis of 50 cents for every one thousand pounds (454kgs) of freight brought into the State, or part thereof. This fee is to be collected at the port of discharge.

Please refer to the following fee schedule as a guide:

Net Weight	Fee
0 to 1,000 pounds	USD0.50
Greater than 1000 pounds to 2000 pounds	USD1.00
Greater than 2000 pounds to 3000 pounds	USD1.50, etc
